Prior to the Small Business office, Mrs. Mudd-Yarber served as Deputy Chief, Contract Airlift Division from June 2013 – June 2016; the Specialized Sealift Branch Chief from April 2012 – June 2013; the Chief, Sealift Administration Branch in March 2010 – April 2012 and the Chief of the Domestic CRAF Branch, from August 2008 – March 2010.

Prior to joining United States Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM), Mrs. Mudd-Yarber worked for the Air Mobility Command (AMC). Her tenure with AMC was from September 1989 – August 2008, holding positions as the Contract Specialist and Contracting Officer of the International CRAF contracts and Perishable Subsistence contracts; Contracting Officer of the Master Solicitation and Chief for the Domestic Airlift Procurement Branch. She started her civil servant career as a Contract Specialist intern with the Army Aviations Systems Command (AVSCOM), in St. Louis MO in October 1985.
